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Black Cove Complex Wildfire Update

Evacuation Level 2 – Yellow

Wilderness Cove, Green River, Sams Gap Lane, Glen Echo Cir, Lady Slipper and Maybank

Evacuation Level 1 - Green

Piney Gate, Fox Paw and Big Hungry

Evacuation Zone Lifted (White)

Holbert Cove, Turkey Track Holbert Cove, Spurgeon Cove Ln, Saluda, Rixhaven, Lake Adger and White Oak Mountain

Polk County, NC – North Carolina Forest Service continues to work to ensure that the Black Cove Complex Fires are safely extinguished. As areas and roads reopen, we ask that residents drive slowly in these affected areas as fire crews are working along some of these lines, either on foot or with heavy equipment. Acreage numbers may shift as the assessment abilities improved.

Current Wildfire Conditions

Black Cove Fire – 3,502 acres | 93% Containment | 0 Mandatory Evacuations

Deep Woods Fire – 3,969 acres | 60% Containment | 0 Mandatory Evacuations

Fish Hook Fire – 199 acres | 100% Containment | 0 Mandatory Evacuations

Polk County Evacuations

Zero mandatory evacuations remain in effect for Polk County. Preparedness zones continue to downgrade for Polk County residents. Evacuation Preparedness Zones can be found on the interactive map located at www.PolkNC.gov/FireUpdates.

Road Closures

Holbert Cove Road and Green River Cove Road are currently open to residents only. Please be mindful of Emergency Personnel in the area and near the roadways.
